



## New Membership Fees

The last realignment of the membership fees has been done when the Euro had been introduced, around 15 years ago. A lot of things changed in the meantime. Mainly: FIPRES CI became bigger – more members, more activities (juries, prizes, events). With the regular fee, these challenges cannot be mastered anymore. To be permanently in the red is no desirable situation. The membership fee needed therefore urgently to be adapted to the current state of affairs, of work, of tasks.

Here are the new fees, as decided by the general assembly of 2017, in April 2017 in Bari.

### **Basic Fee**

(for national sections and individual members, per year)

National Sections: 300 €

Sections in countries ranked by The World Bank as "low income economies" or as "lower middle income economies": 225 €

National sections made up of two associations: 225 € per association

Individual members: 50 €

### **Participation Fee**

(for every participation in a jury or event, per participation)

Members of sections and individual members: 50 €

Members (of sections and individual members) from countries ranked by The World Bank as "low income economies" or as "lower middle income economies": 30 €

The concerned lower income economies are, by January 2018:

Armenia, Bangladesh, Egypt, India, Morocco, Sri Lanka, Tunisia, Ukraine.

New membership fees to become effective from January 1, 2018.
