Board Meeting January 2017

Decision minutes

January 9th, 2017, 6 pm

Participants, via Skype: Alin Tasciyan, Isabelle Danel, Barbara Hollender, György Kárpáti, Anne Brishoual, Klaus Eder.

Barbara Hollender has finalized her questionnaire about the professional situation of film critics, to be sent to all members. Decision is made to add some specific questions on space in print and new technologies. Barbara is still looking for money to hire a professional organization to analyze the answers.

One of the ways to solve the critical money situation should be the raise of the membership fee. A decision should be made soon : The national sections will have to be informed and to discuss it.
